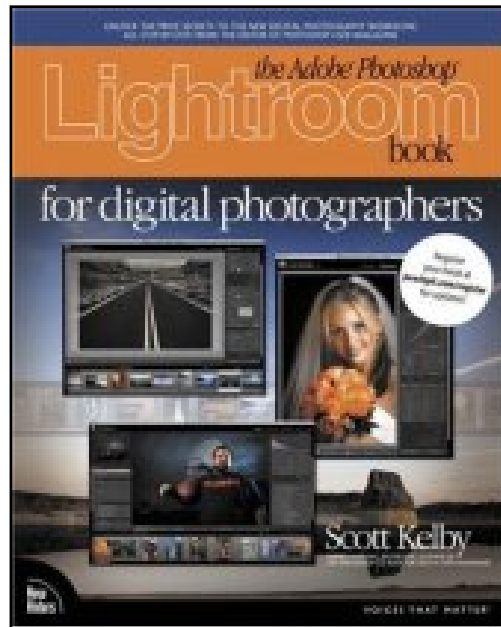

Scott Kelby has a winning formula. (There are many reasons he's the top selling author of all time in his field.) Plain English. Great graphics. Only the information you need to know to get the job done. No nonsense. A little humor.

No matter what your level, his books are rewarding.

If you're just getting started, Scott's books are the ones I recommend. Dive in. Skip beginning level introductions and go straight to Scott. Scott makes great information extremely easy to absorb.

If you're more practiced and looking to catch up on new features, this is the easiest place to start. One

of the most seasoned presenters and prolific authors, Scott's always up to date on the latest advances.

Scott covers all the important bases. He organizes his material by task, rather than delineating every feature of a robust software program.

You just want to get the job done well? This is the book for you.

I've learned a lot about keeping it simple and being more effective at the same time from Scott.
